

The PES Pediatric Endocrinology Clinical Update and Case Discussion Course will highlight clinical challenges encountered in Pediatric Endocrinology practice and provide an opportunity for extended discussion of patient cases with peers and experts in the field. The course will feature both interactive didactic sessions and dialog between attendees and experts so that attendees may share their own challenging cases.

Program/Event Description

The goal of the Course is to address areas and "hot topics" of Pediatric Endocrinology that offer clinicians the greatest challenges, including disorders of gender identity, fertility and hormonal dysfunction in youth survivors of cancer, diabetes/obesity including new options for treatment of type 2 diabetes, endocrine genetics. The course will emphasize newer therapies that have recently become available, as well as therapies on the horizon.

Objectives of the Program

The course will provide a comprehensive review of Pediatric Endocrinology where the learner will be able to:

- 1. Discuss the newest diagnostic techniques for many endocrine disorders of childhood
- 2. Describe the newest management techniques for an array of endocrine disorders
- 3. Implement changes in medical practice based upon new knowledge of treatment and evaluation of pediatric endocrine disorders.

Target Audience

Pediatric and Adult Endocrinologists, and other physicians, and allied health professionals interested in a rigorous and cutting edge update in Pediatric Endocrinology as well as in-depth challenging case discussions.
